To keep active we will do our Superhero Wake and Shake!

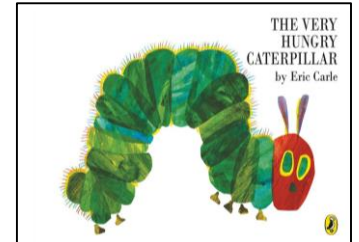
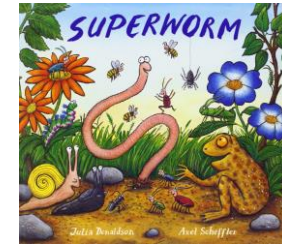


What is a Superhero?
