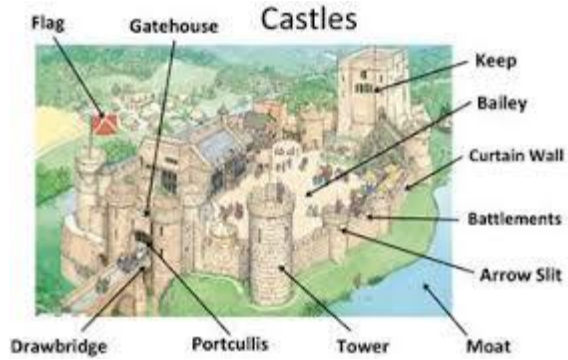


Summer I Main Driver: History: Castles

Features of a castle



Sticky Knowledge:

- A castle is a structure built by soldiers for the Monarchy.
- For a long time, castles were made out of Wood but later made from stone.
- The Keep was high up on the motte and considered the safest place in the castle
- Motte and Bailey castles were a type of castle that had a small hill (motte) surrounded by a bailey (open area)
- Tutbury castle is a very close castle to Chellaston Fields!
- Mary Queen of Scotts was held prisoner four times at Tutbury Castle!

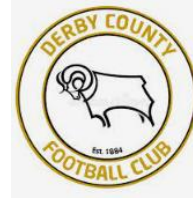
